

LibreOffice Notes

Default "Standard" UI uses toolbars and shows the Spell Check icon.

Optional "Tabbed" UI uses a Word-like ribbon, which does not show the Spell Check icon? Can: -

- a) Press Shift+F7 to toggle Automatic spell checking On or Off.
- b) Press F7 to invoke a manual spell check, or
- c) Click on 'Review' tab then 'Spell Check' icon.

Toolbar 'Icon Style' default is 'Automatic (Colibre)'. 'Karasa Jaga (SVG)' is better but irrelevant **since using the 'Tabbed' UI instead.**

Document background colour: -

(Change it in one app and it applies to all LibreOffice apps.)

Default RGB = 255 255 255

Customised = 200 210 200

Calc: -

Grid lines colour set to 'Light Grey 2'

Redacting [REDACTED] documents: -

- 1) Open [REDACTED] document containing underlined [REDACTED] in Writer then select Tools>Auto-Redact.
- 2) Select the target [REDACTED] then click on OK, which launches the Draw module.
- 3) It is at this point that a preview of the redacted [REDACTED] appears but there is an unwanted effect as well in that any underlined [REDACTED] in the original [REDACTED] document becomes highlighted.
- 4) To create the finished pdf click the 'Redacted Export (Black)' icon on the Redaction toolbar and then choose where to save the pdf file.

Unable to stop underlined [REDACTED] being highlighted so not ideal.
