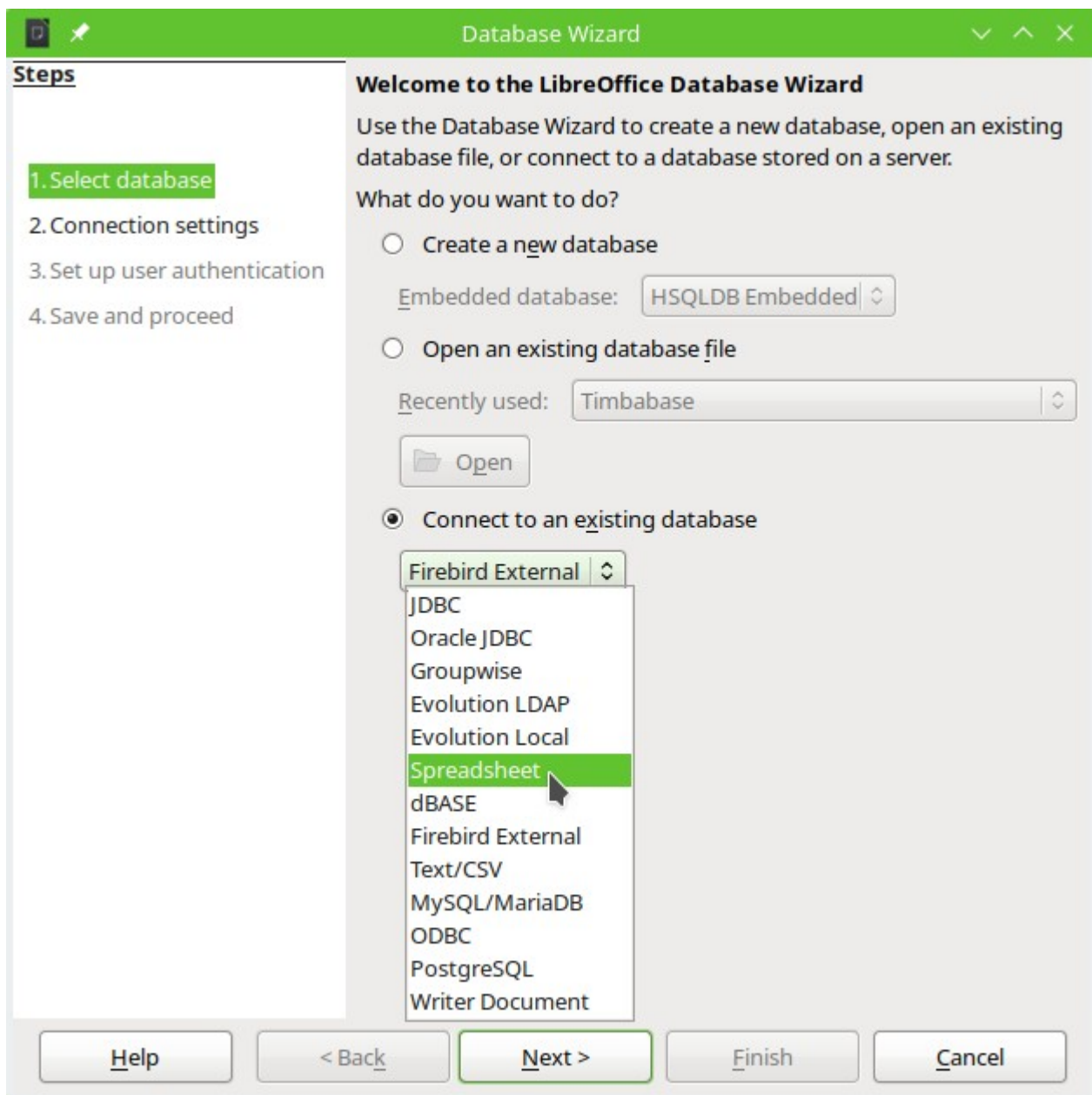

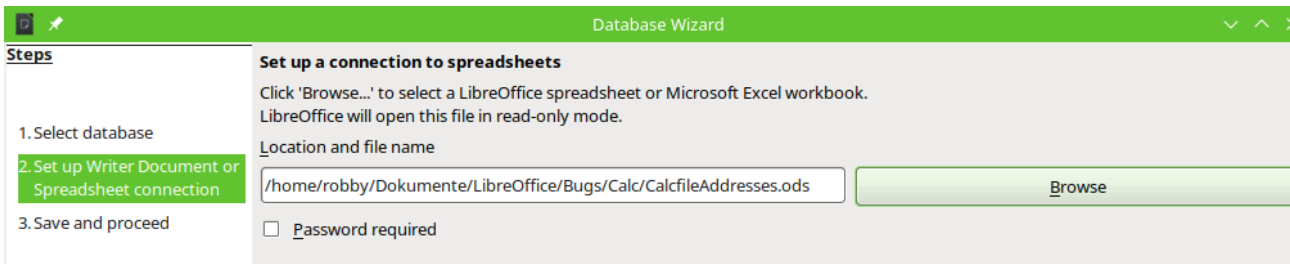

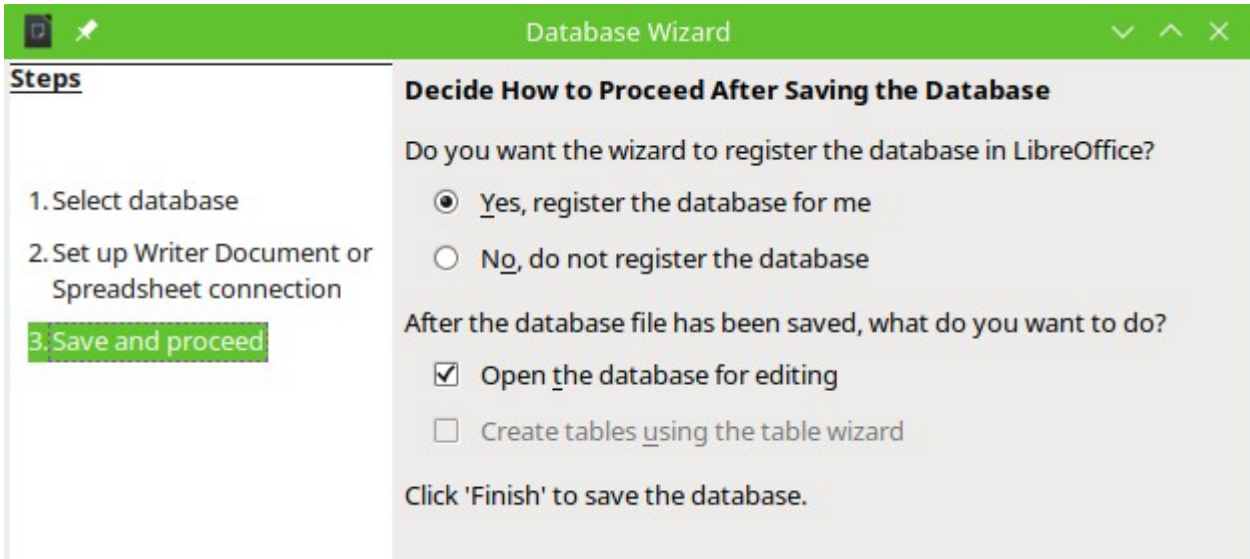
There is a Calc file with some names as example for addresses. The sheet has been named as "CalcAddresses". This name will appear as table name in Base.



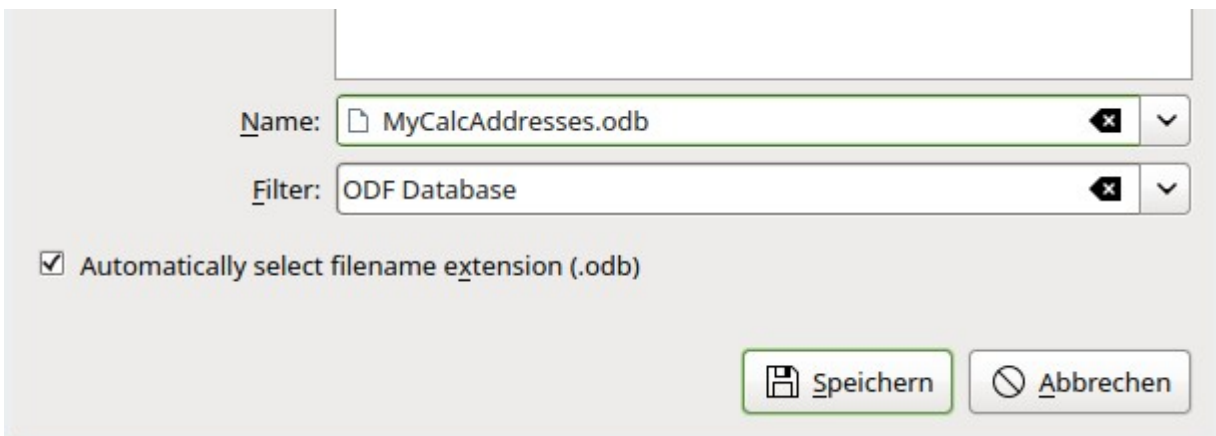
Start the database Wizard from the desktop. Choose "Connect to an existing database" → "Spreadsheet".



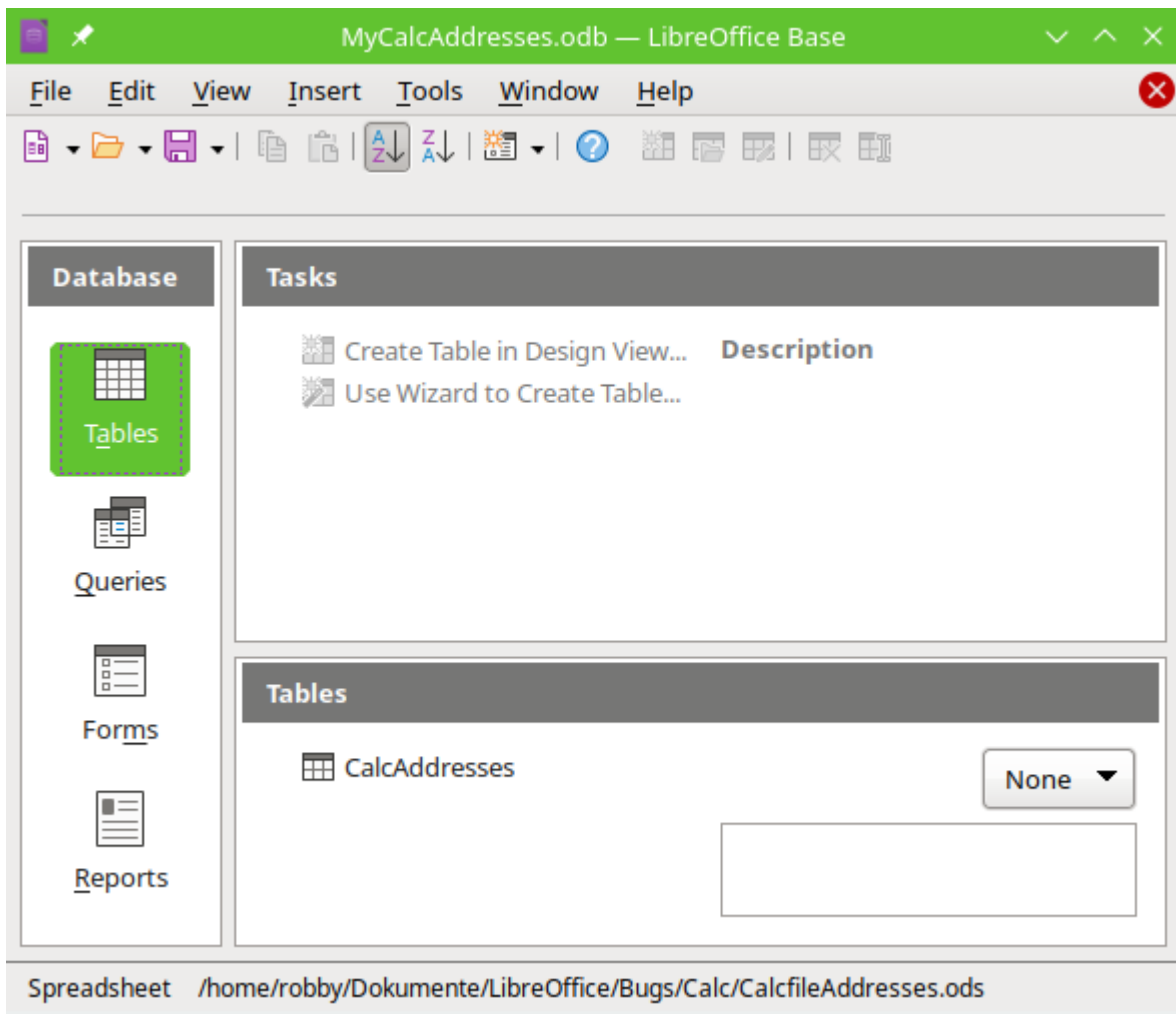
Choose the path to the Calc file. The Calc file is named "CalcfileAddresses.ods" here.



You could register the database at this step. It will be automatically be registered with the name of the database.



Base file will be named "MyCalcAddresses.odt" at this step.

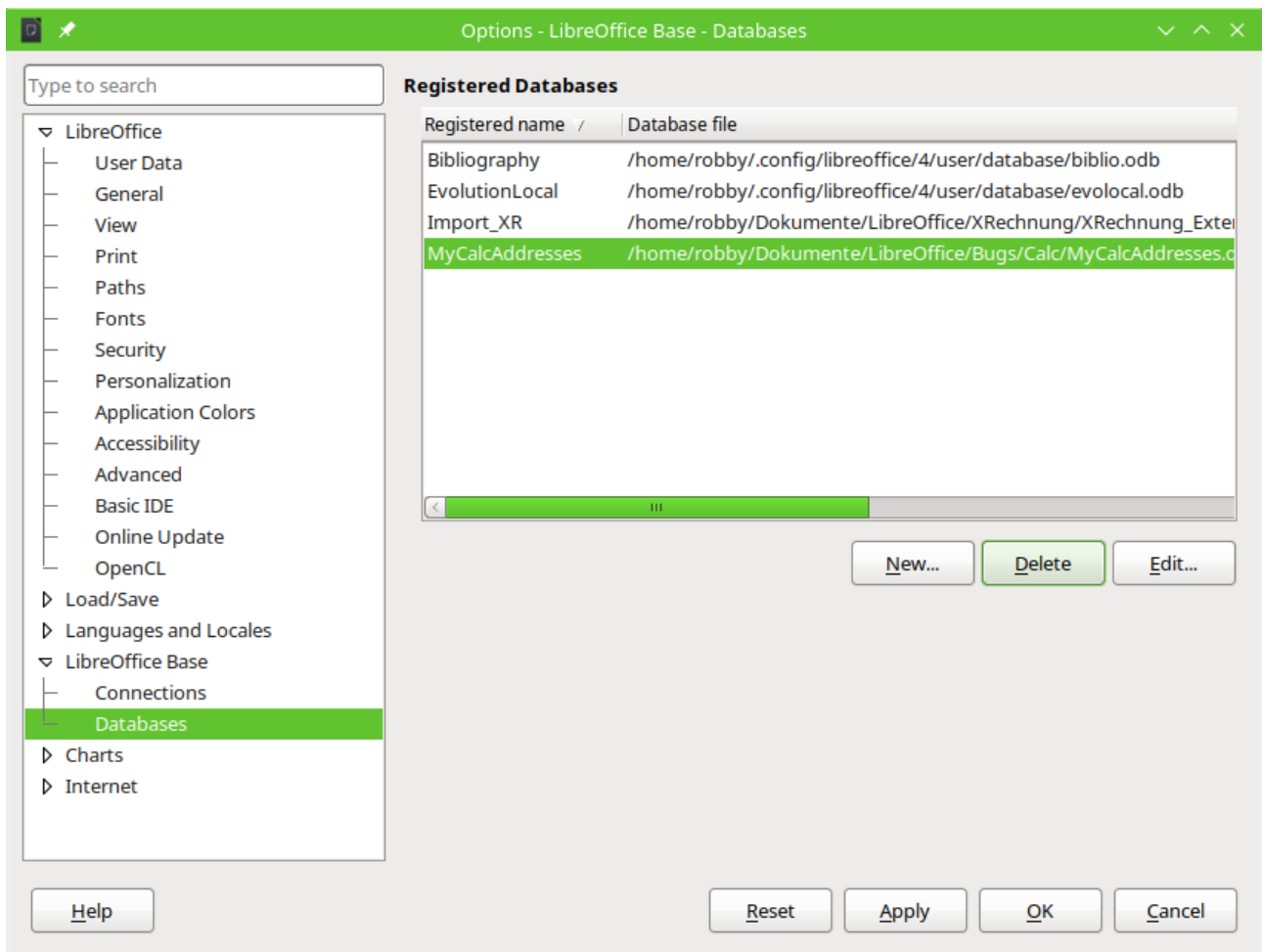


Base file will be opened directly.

Title is "MyCalcAddresses.odb" → name of the Base file.

Tables show "CalcAddresses" → name of the Calc sheet.

Statusbar will show the type of database ("Spreadsheet") and details for the connection (/home/ ...).



If you change to "Tools" → "Options" → "LibreOffice Base" → "Databases" you could see the registered name for the database "MyCalcAddresses". This is the name which will appear when opening Writer and setting "View" → "Data Sources".
